ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season and lame dogs may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.)

For First Time Coursers and Handlers

WHAT ARE PRE-ENTRIES? - Entries made before the closing date. If your entry is mailed in time yet due to the failure of the postal service it is not received in time for the Test Secretary to have it at the Event, then you will have to fill out day of entry forms on the day of the trial. Always have your dog's registration materials with you when you go to a test.

WHAT ARE "DAY OF" ENTRIES? - Entries accepted after the closing date for pre-entries are considered Day of Entries. The deadline for Preentries is typically ten days before the event. "Day of" entries are usually more expensive because the Field Test Secretary (FTS) must take extra time to add those entries to the record sheets the day of the test. If you are entering on the day of the test, be aware that there may be a long delay before you can run.

INSPECTION - Dogs will be inspected by a designated Inspection Committee consisting of at least two persons who are members of the Field Committee or Club and who shall inspect each entered dog for lameness, fitness to compete and female estrus (in season).

Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the Inspection Committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete or in season shall not be allowed to enter and the applicable entry fees shall be refunded.

ROLL CALL - The time, prior to the commencement of running, by which you are supposed to have your dog ready for inspection by the Inspection Committee. At roll call the dog is examined for lameness. Both spayed and unspayed bitches are examined to see if they show any evidence of being in season.

INSPECTION - Must take place before each event the dog is entered in. (Entered in 2 events per day? Then the dog is inspected twice)

RUN ORDER LIST - This is a posted list of the running order for the dogs participating in the event. The Run Order is generated as dogs are inspected

RUN TIMES

We are using SignUp Genius to schedule runs. A link will be emailed to you AFTER entries close.

- 1) Make sure you only sign up for the number of runs per day that you entered! There are 2 runs each day.**
- 2) There are (4) Tabs. One for each day. You need to make sure you click on EACH tab for the days you entered and sign up for a time slot**
- 3) We are limiting the number of people at the field at one time. You will be sent the "Safe Protocols" via email after entries close.**
- 4) We are running CONCURRENT events. What this means is that you can run, rest your dog and then run again within the same time block (you would sign up for 2 runs per dog)**

Ribbons and Rosettes

A Qualifying Run Is Required For All Prizes

A Light Blue Qualifying Ribbon will be given to each dog attaining a Qualifying Run.

New Title Rosettes will be awarded to dogs attaining a BCAT, DCAT, FCAT or FCAT#.

We request that you notify us prior to the event if you feel that your dog may earn a new title.

TRACK CONDITIONS

The Fast CAT track shall be used pursuant to the latest edition of the AKC Fast CAT Regulations. The track will be outdoors and completely fenced. A continuous loop system will be used. The track will be approximately 10 feet wide and a minimum of 460 feet long. Electronic timing devices will be used.

Weather – Fast CAT is an “all weather” activity. We run in rain (shut down if there is lightning), sun, snow (unless the track is icy)

Anyone participating in more than one sport at this event who has a ring conflict, MUST notify the Trial Secretary.

Due to COVI D-19 there will be no spectators or congregating around the track.

FAST CAT

The FAST CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards where a dog chases a lure. Dogs are run singularly and earn points based on their handicapped speed. There are no placements. Titles are issued at designated benchmarks. The dog's time to complete the 100 yard dash is converted into MPH. Dogs earn points based on their handicapped speed. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned.

The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
- Below 12" = handicap is 2.0

$204.545 / \text{time} = \text{MPH}$

Example: The dog's time is 8.14 seconds.

$204.545 / 8.14 = 25.13 \text{ MPH}$

Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap Titles are earned by accumulating points.

The following titles will be awarded:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = every additional 500 points.

Top 20 by Breed by Year: The AKC Fast CAT website will feature the Top 20 Fastest Dogs by Breed by Year national standings. The standings will be updated as event results are processed.

Fast CAT is open to all dogs 12 months of age or older that are individually registered/ listed with the AKC registration as purebreds, Foundation Stock Service (FSS) dogs, Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) dogs and AKC Canine Partner Program.

Fast CAT is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.

ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK

- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entries will be refunded
- Mixed breeds must be spayed or neutered to be eligible to run. AKC registered dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Fast CAT is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength.
- Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded• **A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.**
- **Battery powered, continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic.**
Electronic Timers will be used. Stop watches will be available as back up timers
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
- Bring your own shade and water.
- **No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.**

TIPS FOR HANDLERS

- The track is fenced. However, it is strongly recommended that prior to running your dog, you have good "recall" control over your dog, as the dogs will be off leash.
 - Handlers should wear comfortable shoes and be physically able to hold and release their dogs, as well as catch them. **NO OPEN TOED SHOES/SANDALS**
 - Dogs will be brought to the start line on leash and released only upon a verbal signal ("Tally-Ho!") from the Huntmaster. Dogs may be released by hand, folded leash or using a traditional lure coursing slip lead.
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- **Handler should have someone familiar with the dog at the end of the course to retrieve the dog or have someone else release their dog at the start line. The handler is expected to promptly secure the dog and leave the field with the dog on leash.**

Handlers are allowed to recall their dogs

There will be people willing to help release/catch.

- Lure coursing is a physically demanding sport so please make sure your dog is in good shape. If you are not sure, make an appointment with a veterinarian to get an opinion.
- Handlers are advised to warm up their dogs prior to their run and walk them for about 10 minutes afterwards.
- Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the test by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be under control of their parents or guardian(s) at all times.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH- Dogs must be on leash, held by the handler at all times while on the trial grounds except when on the designated Fast CAT track. Failure to maintain control of a dog may result in an Event Committee hearing. **SPECIAL TRAINING COLLARS ARE PROHIBITED.**

CLEANUP- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s) at the event grounds and all hotels. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be asked to leave the event grounds without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY- The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog because of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

HEALTH & VACCINATIONS- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. A copy of a dog's vaccination record, including a current rabies certificate, must be present for all dogs at the event.

ENTRY- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Fast CAT Entry Form for this event.

LEASHES- It is recommended exhibitors bring 2 leashes (one for the Releaser and one for the Catcher).

RUN TIMES- Runs will be grouped into blocks of time to facilitate social distancing.

EACH DAYS EVENTS WILL BE RUN CONCURRENTLY (meaning you do NOT have to wait until afternoon to run your second run)

COVID-19 INFO

The Covid-19 waiver on the next page must be signed and returned with entry in order for your entry to be valid.

If the waiver is not received by closing your entry will be considered INVALID.

The waiver is the page right before the entry form so please be sure to print both pages if you are using paper entries. If entering online, the waiver will be emailed to you. Please sign it and send to the Test Secretary when you receive your confirmation you will get a copy attached of the waiver which will need to be signed and returned ASAP.

Due to COVID restrictions there will be NO concessions at these events. Please bring food/water/drink for you and your dog.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
